Finally, spring is here, and the sun is shining. I am hopeful we will move out of our monsoon season soon! I would like to take a moment to thank everyone I have encountered in the Fairfield County community. You all have been so welcoming and willing to help me as I have stepped into the role of CEO. I am truly humbled by how many of you care about the community and those that need our help/support.

I have tried to meet as many individuals as I can these first few months but realize I haven't met everyone. So, with that, I would like to introduce myself for those I haven't met in person as of yet. I have been a social worker 20 plus years, leading several nonprofit agencies ensuring impact and reach. I am a passionate advocate for those who are struggling and promise to do all I can to ensure continued funding of the wonderful partner agencies in our community in their quest to alleviate these struggles.

Not only do we fund partner agencies, but we also operate two of our own programs; Dolly Parton's Imagination Library (DPIL) and our VITA/TCE Free Tax Program. Our amazing part-time tax program staff and volunteers completed approximately 1300 tax returns for the 2025 season! Currently, we are providing approximately 5600 children in Fairfield County with monthly book deliveries through the DPIL Program in an attempt to improve early childhood reading literacy. I would like to encourage you to consider a donation to DPIL if your child or grandchild has benefitted from the program. This will allow us to continue serving the children of Fairfield County in the future.

I am excited to announce we have a new website design and would love for you to check it out. We've tried to make it easier for individuals to donate, find information about our programs and programs operated by our funded/partner agencies.

Did You Know?

The United Way of Fairfield County partly funds and operates the Dolly Parton's Imagination Library Program in Fairfield County.

Half of the funding for this program is provided by the United Way of Fairfield County, and the other half is provided by the Governor's Office! The total cost to provide 1 book each month to a child is about \$31, which means that with the Governor's donation match, a \$31 donation today can provide books to TWO children for an entire year!

Dolly Parton's Imagination Library is the flagship program of The Dollywood Foundation, a 501(c)(3) nonprofit Tennessee organization. The Imagination Library is dedicated to inspiring a love of reading by gifting FREE books to children from birth to age five. The program is made possible through funding shared by Dolly Parton herself, and local Program Partners in the United States, Canada, United Kingdom, Australia, and the Republic of Ireland.

Inspired by her father's inability to read and write, Dolly started the Imagination Library in 1995 to serve the children of her hometown in Sevier County, Tennessee. Today, her program spans five countries and gifts over 3 million free, high-quality, age-appropriate books each month to children around the world. There is never a charge to families who participate in the program and it is open to all children under the age of five in geographic areas with operating programs."

Dolly Parton's Imagination Library partners with local communities to gift one free, age-appropriate, high-quality book each month to children from birth to age five.


